Rules and Regulations for Promotion to Higher Semester (ATKT) for UG and PG Students

The following are the ATKT rules for unsuccessful students who shall be allowed to keep the term (ATKT).

- 1. ATKT facility is **not a waiver** of failure; it is an opportunity to continue academic progress while clearing pending subjects/Credits.
- 2. All students are advised to go through the ATKT policy mentioned in the Table 1 (For UG: BTech) and Table 2 (For PG: MTech, MBA, and MCA).
- 3. Students failing to clear backlogs within the stipulated time may be detained or required to discontinue in current year.
- 4. In case of doubts or clarifications, students should contact their **Department** or the **Examination** Cell.

For Postgraduate (PG)

Admission to academic year	Eligibility for admission and taking End Semester Examination		
Semester-I	Candidate should have padded the qualification examination as per Direction governing the course.		
Semester-II	Candidates should have completed the term of Semester-I and Filled examination form or appear for examination.		
Semester-III	The candidate should have completed the term of Semester-II, filled the examination form for the same, and shall be exempted in 50% of the credits of Semester-I and II taken together.		
Semester-IV	Candidates should have completed the term of Semester-III and filled the examination form of the same.
