AND

**Wanganga College Of Engineering And Management**, an education institution, having its address at Dongargarh, near Gungam Rly. Station, Post - Gungam, Waruda Road, Nagpur, Maharashtra, 441114, hereinafter referred to as "Institution" which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, mean and include its successors and assigns) of the **SECOND PART**

IDP and Institution shall hereinafter collectively be referred to as "Parties" and individually as "Party".

#### WHEREAS:

This includes information about the Parties or their group companies, customers, clients, suppliers, and third parties, including but not limited to personally identifiable information of the students, business affairs, strategies, marketing, and other business activities. Each Party agrees to take all appropriate measures to safeguard and protect the Confidential Information against unauthorized disclosure, misuse, loss, and theft, and shall not, without prior written consent, disclose or use any Confidential Information for its own benefit or gain.

5.2 The Parties shall ensure that access to Confidential Information is limited to those authorized representatives of such Party who need to know such Confidential Information in connection with this Agreement. The Parties shall also ensure that restrictions not less stringent than the ones under this Agreement shall be enforced upon such authorized representatives to ensure that Confidential Information shall be used only for the purpose of performing its obligations under this Agreement.

5.3 The Parties acknowledge and agree that Confidential Information of each Party is unique and valuable to each Party respectively, and that breach of the confidentiality obligations provided herein may cause substantial, immediate and irreparable damage to the non-defaulting Party for which monetary damages alone would not be an adequate remedy. Upon any such breach, or in the event that the non-defaulting Party forms a reasonable and good faith belief that such a breach is imminent, non-defaulting Party shall be entitled to seek preliminary and other injunctive relief. This remedy shall be in addition to any and all other rights or remedies to which non-defaulting Party may be entitled at law or in equity.

5.4 The Parties shall comply with all applicable data protection and privacy laws and regulations and shall implement appropriate technical and organizational measures to ensure the security, confidentiality, and integrity of personally identifiable data of the individuals.

5.5 The confidentiality obligations of the Parties shall survive expiry or termination of this Agreement.

#### Intellectual Property Rights

6.1 Each Party, including its group companies and respective right holders (as the case may be) shall retain exclusive ownership of its respective Intellectual Property Rights worldwide and in perpetuity. Neither Party shall: (a) acquire any rights, title, or interest in the Intellectual Property Rights of the other Party or its respective right holders; nor (b) claim or assert any rights, title, or interest in the Intellectual Property Rights of the other Party or its respective right holders, nor take any action that would impair the rights, title, or interest of the other Party or its respective right holders in their Intellectual Property Rights.

6.2 Neither Party shall use the Intellectual Property of the other Party or its respective right holders without prior written consent. If permitted, such use shall be strictly limited to the scope and purpose as expressly specified in writing and solely for fulfilling the obligations of this Agreement.

6.3 Institution shall use promotional materials provided by IDP, solely for promoting Products to students in the manner explicitly outlined by IDP in writing.

6.4 Institution and IDP shall mutually agree on any co-branding activities prior to their implementation. Both Parties shall collaboratively review and approve the use of branding elements ensuring that all marketing and promotional content featuring either Party's brand is in accordance with agreed-upon specifications. Any materials intended for publication or distribution must receive prior written consent from both Parties.

7. **Force Majeure:** Neither Party shall be considered to be in default of performance of its obligations under the terms of this Agreement, if such performance is prevented or delayed for reasons of Force Majeure event which is defined as any event beyond the reasonable control of the affected Party, including but not limited to acts of the government authorities, government-imposed restrictions, pandemics, epidemics, acts of God, fire, flood, explosions, riots, war, rebellion, insurrection and sabotage. The Parties shall forthwith resume their duties and obligations under this Agreement upon the cessation of the Force Majeure event.

#### Term, Termination and Consequences

8.1 This Agreement shall come into force from the date of this Agreement and remain in force for a period of two (2) years, unless terminated earlier by the Parties in writing. The Parties may agree in writing to renew this Agreement on such terms as may be mutually agreed between the Parties.

8.2 Either Party shall have the right to terminate this Agreement, without cause, by giving a 60 (sixty) days' prior written notice to the other Party.

8.3 Each Party shall have the right to forthwith terminate this Agreement if the other Party commits a breach of any of its representations, warranties, and/or terms of this Agreement and in case of breach capable of remedy, fails to remedy the breach within fifteen (15) days upon receipt of a written notice giving particulars of the breach and requiring it to be remedied.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)

This memorandum of understanding (hereafter called as the 'MoU') is entered into on the 03-02-2023 by and between.

WAINGANGA COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING AND MANAGEMENT, DONGARGAON, NAGPUR, the first party represented herein by its Principal / Director / Head of the Institution, WAINGANGA COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING AND MANAGEMENT, DONGARGAON, NAGPUR And SHARADA ACADEMY FOR FOREIGN ACCENTS AND LINGUISTICS, NAGPUR the Second Party, and represented herein by its Director Mr Ambarish D Chandrayan

Whereas:

- First Party is a Higher Educational Institution named WAINGANGA COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING AND MANAGEMENT, DONGARGAON, NAGPUR.
- First Party and Second Party believe that collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their resources and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities.
- The Parties intend to co-operate and focus their efforts on cooperation within area of Internship, Skill Based Training Education.

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERE TO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

#### CO-OPERATION

- Both parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish co-operation.
- First Party and Second party co-operation will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities.
- The Parties shall co-operate with each other and shall promptly as is reasonably practical relevant agreement.

In respect of conduct of need based skill development training courses under CEP for benefit to the society keeping in mind the above, the parties desiring to work together for mutual benefits and agree to design, develop, implement and evaluate CEP courses with the following understanding concept, terms, and conditions.

#### 1. EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE:

##### 1.1 MEMBERS:

An Executive Committee consisting of 85 Members, 03 from institute and 82 from Sharada Academy for Foreign Accents and Linguistics shall be constituted. The Wainganga College of Engineering and Management, Nagpur (WCEM) shall be represented by the Principal and two nominees from the institute. The Sharada Academy for Foreign Accents and Linguistics will be represented by the two members that will be decided by Sharada Academy for Foreign Accents and Linguistics who are accountable for the implementation and the decision taken by the Executive Committee. The Sharada Academy for Foreign Accents and Linguistics shall inform the name and the designation of the two members. Membership of those appointed to the Executive Committee by virtue of the office they hold shall be terminated when they cease to hold the office.

##### 1.2 FUNCTIONS OF EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE:

- It is the Apex policy decision-making body that supports continuing education initiatives to master the support of all concerned for the effective implementation of planned activities.
- Without prejudice generally of the foregoing provisions the Executive Committee shall have the following powers and rights.
  - To lay down general policies for (Name of Training Provider) in implementing its objectives and functions with respect to the affairs of the training programs organized through WCEM.

8. TERMINATION OF MoU:

- MoU will remain in force for 01 years from the date of signing.
- This MoU can be terminated with mutual agreement between (Sharada Academy For Foreign Accents And Linguistics, Nagpur) and WCEM with a resolution passed in the Executive committee meeting.
- The date of termination shall be decided in the meeting and the fact shall be informed to each other.
- In the event of some of the programs are in the mid way in the state of termination it is mandatory on the part of (Sharada Academy For Foreign Accents And Linguistics, Nagpur) to complete all commitment that has been agreed upon by this MoU.
- The WCEM shall be in no way responsible for honoring. Such commitments will not be issued in any court in India or any other part of the world in this regard.

9. AMENDMENT:

- Amendment to this agreement may be made by the Executive committee by a majority decision of members present and voting at the meeting conveyed for the purpose, provided that members present and voting at that time be not less than three.

10. ASSIGNABILITY:

10.1 Neither WCEM nor (Sharada Academy For Foreign Accents And Linguistics, Nagpur) shall assign the agreement to any other / third without the consent, in writing of the other party.

#### 11. SEVERABILITY:

11.1 The clauses in this agreement will be considered severable. The invalidation or cancellation of one or more clauses will not affect the validity of clause of the agreement as a whole.

#### 12. FORCE MAJEURE

No party shall be liable for delay in performance or for non performance caused by circumstance beyond his control including but not limited to weather, wars, acts of terrorism, fires, floods, earthquake, non-negligent equipment break down, government action, accident, labour trouble, equipment shortage or other transportation interruption. The party affected shall immediately inform the other parties indicating the expected duration and extend reasonable action to settle such contingencies so that the performance of obligations under this agreement can be resumed as quickly as possible.

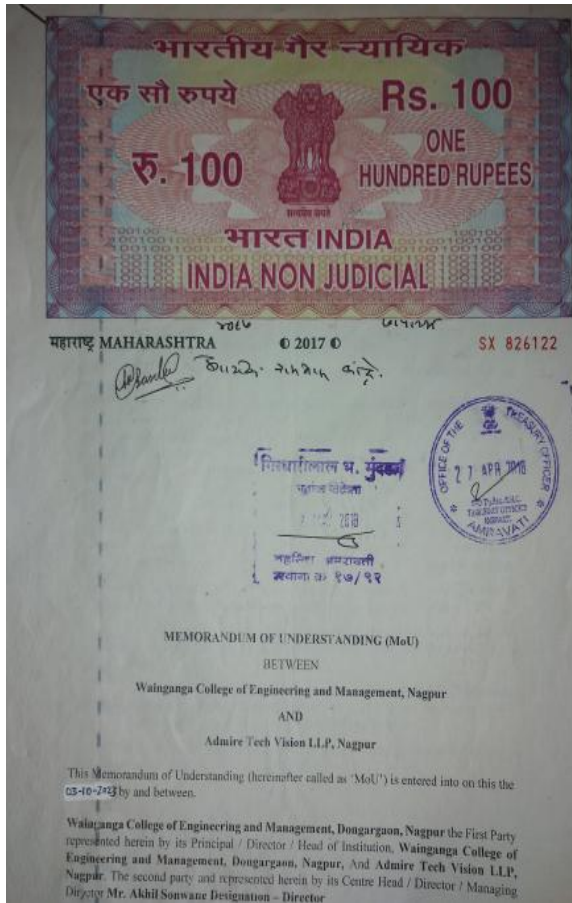

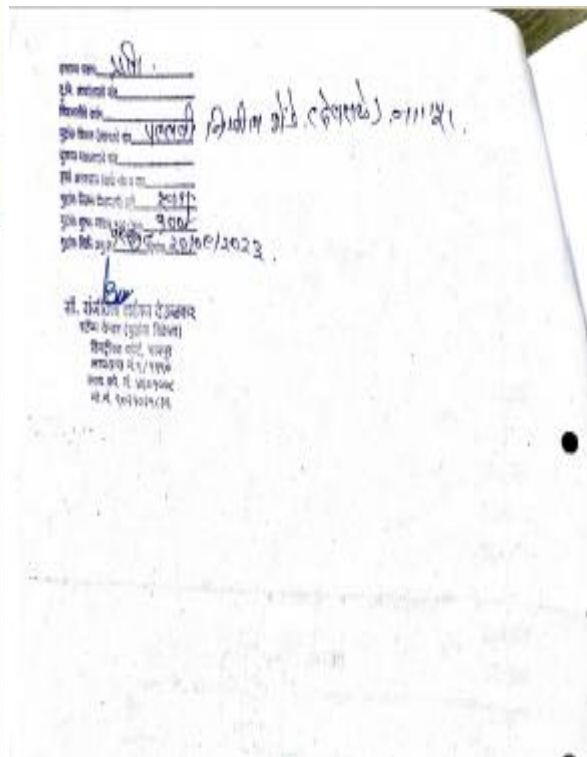

G) NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERETO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

### CLAUSE 1 CO-OPERATION

- 1.1 Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the institution and its related wings. The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.
- 1.2 First Party and Second Party co-operation will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the faculty of First Party providing significant inputs to them in developing suitable teaching / training systems, keeping in mind the needs of the industry, the Second Party.
- 1.3 The general terms of co-operation shall be governed by this MOU. The Parties shall cooperate with each other and shall, as promptly as is reasonably practical, enter into all relevant agreements, deeds and documents (the "Definitive Documents") as may be required to give effect to the actions contemplated in terms of this MOU. The term of Definitive Documents shall be mutually decided between the Parties. Along with the Definitive Documents, this MOU shall represent the entire understanding as to the subject matter hereof and shall supersede any prior understanding between the Parties on the subject matter hereof.

### CLAUSE 2 SCOPE OF THE MOU

- 2.1 The budding graduates from the institutions could play a key role in technological up-gradation, innovation and competitiveness of an industry. Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be of major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge.
- 2.2 Curriculum Design: Second Party will give valuable inputs to the First Party in teaching / training methodology and suitably customize the curriculum so that the students fit into the industrial scenario meaningfully.



### CLAUSE 3 INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

- 3.1 Nothing contained in this MOU shall, by express grant, implication, estoppel or otherwise, create in either Party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents, copy rights and designs) of the other Party.

### CLAUSE 4 VALIDITY

- 4.1 This Agreement will be valid until it is expressly terminated by either Party on mutually agreed terms, during which period **UNIQUE CIVIL**, the Second Party, as the case may be, will take effective steps for implementation of this MOU. Any act on the part of Training Partner or **UNIQUE CIVIL**, the Second Party after termination of this Agreement by way of communication, correspondence etc., shall not be construed as an extension of this MOU.
- 4.2 Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of Termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations.

### CLAUSE 5 RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

- 5.1 It is expressly agreed that **First Party** and **Second Party** are acting under this MOU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MOU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name in any way, to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MOU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party. Any divergence or difference derived from the interpretation or application of the MOU shall be resolved by arbitration between the parties as per the Arbitration Act, 1996. The place of the arbitration shall be at District Head Quarters of the First Party.

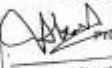
