

WHEREAS

First Party is one of the most reputed colleges in Nagpur **Wainganga College of Engineering and Management**. The First Party & Second Party believe that collaboration and cooperation between themselves will promote a more effective use of each of their resources, and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities.

A) The Parties intent to cooperate and focus their efforts on cooperation within the areas of Skill Based Training, Education and Research.

B) Both Parties, being legal entities in themselves, desire to sign this MOU for advancing their mutual interest.

C) **GGC'S PRACTICAL TRAINING ACADEMY PRIVATE LIMITED**, the Second Party is engaged in the business of financial consultancy and training and skill development and **GGC'S PRACTICAL TRAINING ACADEMY PRIVATE LIMITED**, the Second Party is promoted by the Promoter named CA Smit Tijaria, GGC'S PRACTICAL TRAINING ACADEMY PRIVATE LIMITED.

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERETO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

CLAUSE 1: CO-OPERATION

1.1 Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the **Institution** and its related wings. The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all the information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.

1.2 First Party and Second Party co-operation will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the faculty of First Party, providing significant inputs to them in developing suitable teaching/training systems, keeping in mind the needs of the industry, the Second Party.

1.3 The general terms of co-operation shall be governed by this MOU. The Parties shall co-operate with each other and shall, as promptly as is reasonably practical, enter into all relevant agreements, deeds, and documents (the "Definitive Documents") as may be required to give effect to the actions contemplated in terms of this MOU. The term of Definitive Documents, this MOU shall represent the entire understanding as to the subject matter hereof and shall supersede any prior understanding between the Parties on the subject matter hereof.

CLAUSE 2: SCOPE OF THE MOU ALONG WITH TERMS & CONDITIONS

2.1 The budding finance graduates from the Institutions could play a key role by acting as skilled finance professionals of an industry. Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be of major benefit to the student and youth community to enhance their skills and knowledge and employability.

2.2 **Training Methodology**: Second Party would provide virtual training to students of First Party.

2.3 **Hands on Training**: The practical training and exposure provided to selected students through internship opportunities will build confidence and prepare the students to have a smooth transition from academic to working career.

2.4 **Internships and Placements of Students**: Second Party will actively engage to help the delivery of the Internship and Placement of Selected Students of the First Party into internships/jobs. Internships would be given to only those candidates who would be clearing the Eligibility Test (ET) which would be conducted post 45 days of training. For clearing the ET, a minimum of 60% score needs to be secured by the enrolled students.

2.5 **Skill Development Programs** – Second Party to train the students of First Party on the emerging cloud-based technologies in order to bridge the skill gap and make them industry ready.

2.6 Both Parties to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and licences of whatever nature required for offering the Programs on the terms specified herein.

2.7 It is agreed between the parties that Second Party would provide virtual training on 8 modules as listed on the website of second party for 45 days.

2.8 Students of First party should have Android mobile phones on which mobile application of Second Party would be downloaded from the app store, and once all formalities are completed, then a unique user ID and password would be created for each enrolled student.

2.9 Schedule to watch the learning sessions would be shared on day one, and on WhatsApp daily follow up would be done by team of Second Party to make sure that students are watching the lectures as per the schedule. A report of students who are not sincere would be shared in the First Party by Second Party so that necessary follow ups can be done by the First Party.

2.10 A certificate would also be issued by Second Party to all the candidates of First Party based on the scores of the Eligibility Test (ET).

2.11 It is clearly agreed between First Party and Second Party that Course (I) i.e., Financial Management would be provided by Second Party to the First Party for a period of 45 days on 8 topics listed along with the attached brochure and each enrolled student needs to pay the required fees of Rs. 1,000.

2.12 It is clearly agreed between First Party and Second Party that Second Party will be conducting the other 3 Courses, Tax Audit & GST Annual Compliances, Finance Minor Course & Statutory Registrations Roadmap. Student opting for these courses needs to pay the required fees of Rs. 500 per course per student. Since in the Financial Minor Course of Second Party, the intent of Second Party is just to inculcate the sense of "How to Manage the earned money", an employment opportunities can be provided in the second course.

CLAUSE 3: INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

3.1 Nothing contained in this MOU shall, by express grant, implication, estoppel or otherwise, create in either Party any right, title, interest, or license (or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to knowhow, inventions, patents, copy rights and designs) of the other Party.

CLAUSE 4: VALIDITY

4.1 This Agreement will be valid for 1 academic year from the date of signing until it is expressly terminated by either Party or mutually agreed terms, during which GGC'S PRACTICAL TRAINING ACADEMY PRIVATE LIMITED the Second Party, will take effective steps for implementation of this MOU.

4.2 Both Parties may terminate this MOU after 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations.

CLAUSE 5: RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

5.1 It is expressly agreed that First Party and Second Party are acting under this MOU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MOU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name in any way, to make any representation or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MOU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, regardless the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

THE AGREEMENT

This MOU was made and entered into, 5 September 2024, between Walinganga College of Engineering and Management, Near Gangapur Railway Station, Walinganga, Post-Gangapur, Wardha Road, Nagpur, Maharashtra, India (hereinafter referred to as "THE INSTITUTION") which expression shall henceforth include its successors and permitted assigns of this MOU;

And,

Skillship Foundation is a premier institution, founded in 2010, by the Government of India under the India Education Act, 2010, and is located in Nagpur, Maharashtra, India. It is a non-governmental organization (NGO) (hereinafter referred to as "THE ASSOCIATE") which expression shall henceforth include its successors and permitted assigns of this MOU;

This agreement is entered through the Director of THE INSTITUTION and THE ASSOCIATE. The original can be signed off Walinganga College of Engineering and Management, Wardha Road, Nagpur, Maharashtra, India, dated 5 September 2024, which shall be witnessed at other offices.

SCOPE

WHEREAS THE ASSOCIATE is engaged in providing Training, Skill Development, and Entrepreneurial activities and has strength in development and delivery, Innovation, and Research, particularly in the areas of IT and OS and has approached THE INSTITUTION to establish an effective relationship in the larger interest of the sector.

and

WHEREAS THE INSTITUTION is a premier educational college, devoted to the advancement of Science and Technology in Information Technology, Computer Science and other related disciplines, has agreed to this mutual cooperation.

Objectives

To design, develop and deliver programmes creating required skills in the students so that they will be prepared to meet the industry requirements and become employable.

To be an IT skill enhancement partner and product integrator for corporate and private agencies.

Carryout Development Programmes (CDP) for Institutions and skill training partners.

Cooperate with industry to establish the curriculum as per its requirements and also with academic in order to enhance the quality of Technical and Engineering education in the country.

Enhance skills of students/experts through Internships and Industrial exposure and innovation program like Hackathons, Bootcamps, mentorship and competitions.

Role of THE INSTITUTION

THE INSTITUTION shall provide the available infrastructure & basic resources, curriculum, faculty, etc., suitable and ready for delivering the training courses and other activities in co-operation with THE ASSOCIATE in the scope.

THE INSTITUTION shall help to develop the market through its existing established contacts and assist in getting co-operation with the permission of the concerned authority of the INSTITUTION.

THE INSTITUTION shall maintain a co-ordinator as a point of contact (POC) for ASSOCIATE for proper operation of MOU.

THE INSTITUTION shall have ASSOCIATE as a management for joint academic activities.

THE INSTITUTION shall provide accommodations and travelling expenses for students and faculty if THE INSTITUTION is out of Nagpur, Maharashtra.

Role of THE ASSOCIATE

The ASSOCIATE shall utilize its strength to work with various Skill Development centres and bodies to meet the objectives of THE INSTITUTION. It shall be responsible to design and deliver various programmes within the overall scope of the MOU.

The specific authority is the responsibility of THE ASSOCIATE and THE ASSOCIATE would have to have in-house or engage the required manpower and the faculty in the requirement, in conjunction with the INSTITUTION.

THE ASSOCIATE shall design, develop and provide practical training to the students in areas THE INSTITUTION makes no programmes to cater them successfully. It shall also do placement for the students for higher placement.

THE ASSOCIATE shall provide a semester-based apprenticeship programme for training new entrants to students and staff at the INSTITUTION.

THE INSTITUTION shall provide 3-6 months intensive program to the students in INSTITUTION and/or abroad.

Joint Responsibilities

Ensuring a satisfaction of the students shall be carried out jointly as per mutually agreed terms.

Development of the programmes undertaken shall be adopted by prospectus through the respective institutes of the parties.

Research in their practical workshops within the scope of the MOU.

Cooperation in the courses shall be carried out jointly by both the parties.

ASSOCIATE shall provide assistance to the students for their academic career in the concerned Institutes either via campus of the INSTITUTION or in ASSOCIATE institutes.

Financial Arrangement

Course fees shall be decided in initial agreement by both the training authority to be paid, possibly to be rendered jointly by THE INSTITUTION and THE ASSOCIATE.

The parties will decide whether the fee decided by THE ASSOCIATE will be collected from the students or not.

Any amount of 50% payment shall be advanced by INSTITUTION, then ASSOCIATE shall start training.

THE INSTITUTION shall not be liable for discharging any financial commitment held by THE ASSOCIATE and vice versa.

INSTITUTION will not be charged any cause fees or any other financial charges.

Duration and Termination of Agreement

MOU shall be effective from the date of signing and shall remain in force for a period of 3 years, it may automatically be renewed for next four years unless discontinued.

In either case or it can be discontinued if the Institute fails to execute one or more development programs within 6 months of MOU duration.

The INSTITUTION has the right to terminate the agreement for non-performance or non-compliance, based on fair hearing due process.

If one day the ASSOCIATE intends to terminate the contract, it shall communicate the DATED letter to its institution in advance and in addition, it shall hand all its documents and the remaining unutilized amount, to the institution of the ASSOCIATE to make it successful.

Intellectual Properties

Both the parties have full power and authority to enter into this MOU and take all actions and other documents required by the terms herein, and that it is understood that both the parties are acting in their individual capacities and bearing no obligation, employment or association with the term "parent", and that the execution of this MOU are duly empowered and authorized to execute this MOU and the parties affirm obligations in accordance with the terms herein.

This agreement shall not be binding for any other agreement for other party, unless and independent to carry out other services and training besides the general course the scope of this agreement.

The ASSOCIATE & THE INSTITUTION shall perform their duties in strict compliance with all applicable laws in India along with rules and regulations of duly constituted authorities in India and shall acquire all licenses, registrations or other approvals, if any, required by laws in India in connection with the services to be rendered by the parties.

The ASSOCIATE shall strictly follow the INSTITUTIONS norms, rules and regulations in conducting the program and shall maintain the INSTITUTIONS high standards.

Both parties can use logo, trade name, service marks & other related materials for promotion of the services to be conducted jointly under the scope of this MOU.

Both parties shall promote their respective local sources through respective websites.

Notices

Unless otherwise provided herein, all notices or other communications under or in connection with this MOU shall be given in writing and may be sent by personal delivery or post or courier or facsimile. Any such notice or other communication will be deemed to be effective if sent by personal delivery, when delivered if sent by post, two days after being deposited in the post and if sent by courier, one day.

Any notice deposited with the carrier, is deemed by facsimile when sent [an hour] to and reaches to the correct destination number.

Arbitration

In the event of a dispute between the ASSOCIATE and the INSTITUTION arising out of or relating to this Agreement, or interpretation or performance hereunder, the parties shall first, their best efforts to resolve the dispute amicably through negotiations.

If no amicable disagreement can be had and the parties fail to mutually resolve the same, both parties shall appoint an arbitrator that is mutually acceptable and shall arbitrate under the Indian Arbitration Act, and arbitration charges shall be divided equally.

Finally, in case the parties fail to resolve the dispute, the Association shall be governed by law relevant to association with the law within the state of Maharashtra, India. The jurisdiction shall be Court of Nagpur High Court.

By witness whereof, each of the parties hereto has caused this Agreement to be duly executed by a duly authorized representative of each party on or the date hereinafter indicated.

Confidentiality

Both parties agree and undertake that all Information (herein "Info") of INSTITUTION and its partners and its clients and belong to the ASSOCIATE and cannot be used by anyone else except for the sole purpose of carrying out the activities of the MOU.

INSTITUTION agrees to keep the Info in confidence for a period of one year from the date of execution of this MOU.

INSTITUTION agrees to consider all information disclosed by both parties as confidential disclosure on mutual trust.






